D. In vs.8, what was Jesus' assessment regarding the UNJUST steward's PLAN?

1.	Jesus did approve of the unjust steward's CONDUCT , but He approved of his SHREWDNESS which was "FORWARD THINKING ."
2.	Therefore, in this parable of the unjust steward, we can learn "A GOOD LESSON from A BAD EXAMPLE." (Lk. 10:30-37)
3.	According to the latter part of vs 8 there are two types of people: <i>children of the world</i> and <i>children of light</i> . Which one are Christians and explain why?

(Matt. 5:14-16; Lk. 9:23-25)

E. In vs. 9, what is mammon? And why did Jesus refer to it as "unrighteous mammon"?

(Lk. 12:16-21; 1Tim.6:17-19)

- 1. So, when Jesus says, *"make friends of unrighteous mammon,"* the implication is to use our **PRESENT** resources to **PLAN** for **ETERNITY**. (vs. 9b)
- 2. As CHRISTIANS we must learn to wisely MANAGE MONEY and never forget the most important LONG-TERM INVESTMENT. Which is INVESTING with an EYE to ETERNITY. (Col. 3:1-4)
- 3. The summation of vs. 9 is that JESUS expects us to be both GODLY and WISE in our use of the RESOURCES and OPPORTUNITIES GOD entrusts to us. (Eph.5:15-17)
