- D. THE WORD BECAME FLESH and DWELT AMONG US. (VS. 14a)
- **1.** The word becoming **FLESH** could not be conceived among both the Jews and Greeks who had a vast distinction between the **CREATOR** and His **CREATION**.
- 2. Christ came in the FLESH to REDEEM our FLESH. (Ps. 103:1-4; 107:1,2)
- 3. John wanted his readers to know that Jesus was really GOD with SKIN ON. The HUMAN BIRTH was CHRIST entering into A NEW DIMENSION of EXISTENCE to DWELL among Mankind. (vss 13,14)
- E. The transliteration of the word "DWELT" means "to encamp, to pitch one's tent."
- **1.** This meaning is a reference to the tabernacle in the Old Testament, where the **SPIRIT** of the **LORD** "dwelled" with **HIS** people. (Ex. 33:7-11; Ex. 34:29-35)
- 2. Just as the LORD pitched His tent among the Israelites, Jesus pitched His tent among His people when HE BECAME A MAN in the FLESH.
- 3. Over, and over in the Old Covenant, God promised to **DWELL** with them, to **WALK** with them, to be their God, to be in relationship with them.

  (Ex. 6:7; 29:45; Jer. 7:23,24; 11:1-4)
- **F.** During **JESUS** time on earth, he was **THE DWELLING PLACE** of **GOD** on **EARTH**.
- 1. In other words, JESUS was GOD'S TEMPLE meaning no longer a BUILDING but a PERSON. (John 2:18-21)
- 2. Because JESUS was GOD in HUMAN FORM and GOD'S SPIRIT DWELLED in JESUS, people didn't have to go A PLACE to MEET GOD, GOD came to them in the form of JESUS. (Matt.1:23)
