Topical Study: THE GOSPEL of JOHN

SESSION TWO: THE LAMB of GOD (John 1:29-37)

II. **THE PASSOVER LAMB** (Exodus 12)

A. What is PASSOVER?

(Ex. 12:24-28)

1. Each year the Jewish community, religious and nonreligious, celebrate the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob by gathering and experiencing the **PASSOVER SEDER**. The **SEDER** is the traditional dinner that Jews partake of as part of **PASSOVER**.
2. The origin of **PASSOVER** occurred when Pharaoh refused to “*Let the Israelites Go,*” and God brought ten plagues on the land of Egypt. (Ex. 6:6-8; Ex. 8:1-2-11:1-10)

3. Why did God release the 10 plagues?

(Gen. 22:15-18; Heb. 3:7-15)

4. On that fateful night of the **FIRST PASSOVER** was the night of the **TENTH** and **FINAL PLAGUE**. (Ex. 11:1-6)

B. What is the **PASSOVER LAMB**?

(Ex. 12:3-5)

1. What part of the **LAMB** was given to **GOD**?

2. What was the sole purpose of “*Marking*” the door posts and lintels with the **BLOOD** of the **LAMB**?

(Ex.12:6-13)

3. All throughout Egypt, behind the unmarked, bloodless doorways of the Egyptians, the first-born children died at midnight. (Ex. 12:21-30)
4. As **BELIEVERS** in **JESUS CHRIST** symbolically we have the “*sacrificial blood*” of **CHRIST** applied to our hearts and we escaped **ETERNAL DEATH**. (Heb. 9:11-14)

“**JESUS is the NEW PASSOVER LAMB!**” (Heb. 9:15-28)
